The Infrastructure Support Administrator supervises and manages the daily activities of configuration and operation of business systems which may be mainframe, mini, or client/server based. Optimizes system operation and resource utilization, and performs system capacity analysis and planning. They should be able to provide assistance to users in accessing and using business systems.

Perform a variety of difficult assignments associated with monitoring and controlling computer operating systems. Supervises and manages the daily activities of configuration and operation of business systems. Optimizes system operation and resource utilization, and performs system capacity analysis and planning. Be able to provide assistance to users in accessing and using business systems. Sets up and maintains more than one type of computer system such as Open VMS Systems/DSM environments, UNIX systems (SCO and SUN), and Windows systems. Analyzes system faults and troubleshoots and runs diagnostic tests on operating systems and hardware to detect problems. Evaluates and installs developed software during various phases of testing. Reviews and prepares documentation for systems, tests and installation of software. Investigates and recommends methods and techniques for obtaining solutions. An ISA should possess the ability to initiate preventive maintenance on the operating systems as well as repair to system/environment problems. ISA's will administer systems/environment solutions for multiple projects with varying schedules. ISA's will interface with vendors for trouble calls. Additionally, support the planning of system/environment requirements for individual projects. May provide work direction and guidance to others.
