Responsible for engineering and designing database systems and applications on a geographically dispersed Enterprise network with multiple types of servers and server applications. Candidates must have knowledge and experience in major relational database languages and applications, such as Microsoft Structured Query Language (SQL) Server, Oracle, and Sybase. Responsible for database server administration functions supporting a global Active Directory infrastructure in a mixed environment. Requires a strong technical foundation in database structure, configuration, installation, operation and maintenance. Must demonstrate the ability to pay keen attention to detail, possess a strong customer service orientation, and have the ability to work as part of a team. Will provide database administration (DBA) support services, to include Tier 3 level expertise, as well as the planning, implementation, and monitoring of patching services for physical and virtual solutions. Monitoring and maintaining databases. Performing requested changes, updates and modifications to database structure and data. Ensuring technical modifications do not adversely affect database integrity, stability and system availability. Implementing solutions for database backup and recovery infrastructure. Database modeling and implementation. User interface development. Ability to produce visualization of data for leadership decision making. May provide work direction and guidance to others. Other duties as assigned.

The successful candidate must be able to communicate clearly and succinctly both written and orally, and present products and ideas in a business-like manner. The

candidate will be required to work in dynamic fast paced environments that require team interaction and coordination of efforts. The candidate must be experienced in interfacing with both client managers and system users.

Provide database administration to include data backups, schema development and maintenance, and database/OS upgrades. Support to Operations and Exercises for Oracle, Sybase, and Microsoft SQL databases. Support Database engineering activities that span across multiple technologies and platforms. Perform engineering functions found in the service design domain and provide escalated support to incident management. Support engineering efforts to design, build, test, integrate, transition, implement, document, and train when transitioned to IT Operations Management.
