Regulates the change process so that only approved and validated changes are incorporated into product documents and related software. Responsible for configuration status accounting. Tracks all problems and changes in product documents and reports changes and current configuration. Responsible for configuration audits. Supports audits to verify that requirements of all baselines have been met. More specifically, the Change Manager will be Responsible for the creation and management of all configuration projects and planning. Develops guidance and advice on methods, procedures and requirements. Responsible for configuration change control. Regulates the change process so that only approved and validated changes are incorporated into product documents. Ensures configuration identification by reviewing design release documents

for completeness, proper authorization and system updates. Authorizes the release of drawings and software configuration changes specified by management and other functional groups. Responsible for configuration status accounting. Tracks all problems and changes in product documents and reports changes and current configuration. Responsible for configuration audits. Supports audits to verify that requirements of all baselines have been met. Supports quality assurance process audits and manages staff of configuration specialists for a new software development application. Provides leadership and training for less experienced CM specialists. Leads, directs, and reviews the work of the CM team to ensure the programs operational goals are met.
